4. Applicants will be evaluated and judged on the following factors:
  - a. Transcript of applicant's scholastic record;
  - b. Activity Record to include activities within Lincoln and the outside community.
  - c. A personal statement of their experiences and future goals.
  - d. A character reference letter from current ALHS faculty/staff.
5. Scholarship recipients will be announced during the Senior Awards Assembly in May and checks will be mailed to the recipient within a week of announcement. - GPA 2.5 or better

- Minimum of 3 years in JROTC
- 3.0 GPS overall and in JROTC
- Excellent citizenship
- Attending a 4 year institution of higher learning

- Demonstrated character, leadership, and a high level of physical fitness
- Has participated in and given time to charitable giving activities.
